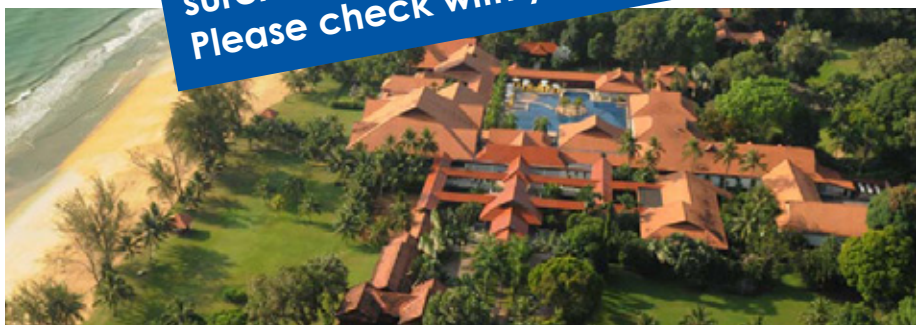

DELTA Air Lines has confirmed it is introducing a Premium Economy cabin to its long-haul international services, including flights between Los Angeles and Sydney. 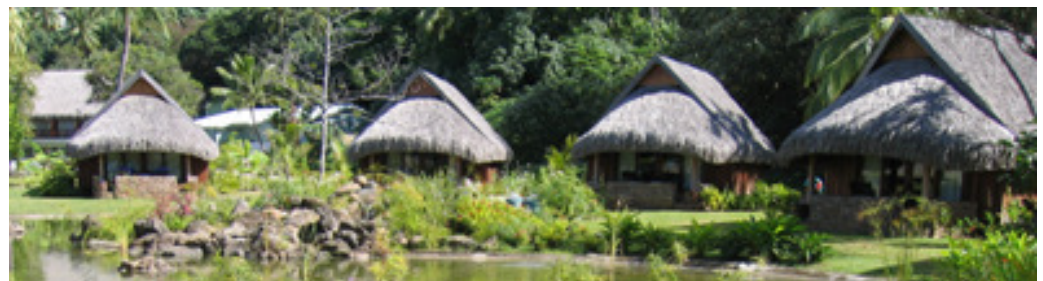
