## YOUR ITINERARY

### FRIDAY 20 MAY

Fly from Hobart or Launceston to London via Melbourne

### SATURDAY 21 MAY

#### ARRIVE LONDON

Upon arrival at London Heathrow we will be transferred to our centrally located hotel. We will explore the surrounding area including Trafalgar Square and Piccadilly Circus, all within a comfortable walk from our hotel. Stop for a coffee or a pint in a local pub before an early night.

### SUNDAY 22 MAY

#### LONDON B,D

Full day tour of London today, with the morning portion based on a panoramic tour with some photo stops. We will see the Houses of Parliament, Westminster Abbey and go to Buckingham Palace to see the Changing of the Guard. In the afternoon we will enjoy a guided tour of the Tower of London and to finish we will enjoy a River Thames cruise before being returned to our hotel. This evening we will enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.

### MONDAY 23 MAY

#### LONDON B,AT

This morning is free to explore city sights as you wish – the choices are endless. This afternoon enjoy 'High Tea', in keeping with English tradition, at Kensington Palace. This evening we will be heading off to the theatre in the West End (show to be advised).

### TUESDAY 24 MAY

#### B LONDON - OXFORD - LONDON

We journey into the countryside this morning to Oxford. Within one hour we arrive in this beautiful university town which remains largely untouched allowing us to experience the 750 year old architecture. A local guide takes us on a walking tour around the city and its college. Early evening we return to London and our hotel.

### WEDNESDAY 25 MAY

#### B LONDON

After breakfast this morning we make our way to the Chelsea Flower Show, the greatest flower show in the world. It's the garden design equivalent of Paris Fashion Week.

### THURSDAY 26 MAY

#### B LONDON - PARIS

Off to France today. We board the high-speed Eurostar for a journey under the English Channel and arrive in the city of Paris in just a few hours. This evening we have a short walk from our hotel to Montparnasse Tower. After a 38 second ride upwards we will enjoy

the breathtaking views of Paris whilst sipping on a glass of champagne in the highest bar in Paris.

### FRIDAY 27 MAY

#### PARIS B, L

After breakfast our local guide will show us all the major sights of Paris including the Notre-Dame Cathedral, Arc de Triomphe, the famous Champs Elysees. On completion of this tour we will travel to the Eiffel Tower and have lunch at 58 Tour Eiffel where we will dine overlooking the Paris skyline.

### SATURDAY 28 MAY

#### B,D PARIS

This morning we leave Paris and travel to the Palace of Versailles where we will enjoy a guided visit of the King's and Queen's State Apartments and the newly restored 'Hall of Mirrors'. Free time to explore the Palace gardens. The rest of the day is at your leisure until this evening, as we have reservations on Marina de Paris Seine dinner cruise. Whilst enjoying our meal we have impressive views of Paris and its illuminated monuments.

### SUNDAY 29 MAY

#### B PARIS

Today we explore Paris on foot including a visit to the Luxembourg Gardens and enjoy a cruise on the River Seine. Today you can catch up on shopping, visit one of the museums, whatever you desire.

Early this evening we will be transferred to Montmartre – an area of Paris unlike any other. Here we will enjoy a Parisian dinner. Montmartre has the feel of a small French village with magnificent views of the rest of the city. Artists such as Picasso, Van Gogh and Renoir lived here for inspiration.

### MONDAY 30 MAY

#### B PARIS - AVIGNON

We travel today by TGV Train to Avignon in southern France, where we will spend the next three nights.

### TUESDAY 31 MAY

#### B AVIGNON - PROVENCE -AVIGNON

This morning we will enjoy this beautiful walled city until our coach will collect us and we will spend the afternoon enjoying the countryside in Provence and visiting neighbouring villages.

### WEDNESDAY 1 JUNE

#### B AVIGNON

We have set aside today to enjoy the local market in St Remy de Provence, as Wednesday is major market day. The market offers traditional and more unusual crafts as well as clothes, shoes and a huge range of fresh local produce. We will return to Avignon in the early afternoon. This afternoon and evening are at your leisure.

### THURSDAY 2 JUNE

#### B,D AVIGNON - NICE

After breakfast we depart Avignon and travel to Nice, the sophisticated "Queen of the Riviera". This afternoon we enjoy the Cote D'Azur at our own pace, looking at the elegant shops, walk along the Promenade des Anglais and the Old Town and its colourful flower markets. Dinner this evening is included.

### FRIDAY 3 JUNE

#### B NICE

Our tour today will include a stop at the village of Eze, perched high on a cliff above the Mediterranean Sea. Whilst we are there we have the chance to visit a traditional perfume factory and wander around the village where every street is full of charm and history. We then make our way to Monaco where we will see the Cathedral where Princess Grace is buried and the Palace. Of course no Monaco tour would be complete without a stroll around Monte-Carlo. The journey back to Nice will be via the 'Basse Corniche' for more superb views.

### SATURDAY 4 JUNE

#### B NICE - SANTA MARGHERITA

This morning we leave the French Riviera and travel to Santa Margherita, a charming seaside resort where we will visit the Cinque Terre on the Italian Coast. Cinque Terre means 'five lands', and comes from the five unspoilt fishing villages that cling to the cliffs, overlooking the sea. The area has been proclaimed a major national park and is a unique part of Italy.

### SUNDAY 5 JUNE

#### B SANTA MARGHERITA

A train ride takes us to Riomaggiore, the most southerly of the five villages of the Cinque Terre and one of the prettiest. After time to enjoy this quaint village, we start the most famous of all walks in the area (very easy) – the 'Sentiero dell'Amore' (Lover's Walk) from Riomaggiore to Manarola, an attractive little village with steep multi-coloured houses overlooking a rocky port.



**MONDAY 6 JUNE B, D****SANTA MARGHERITA**

Today we travel along the Ligurian coast to the exclusive and elegant village of Portofino. Time to admire the gaily coloured houses, browse the boutiques, stay a while in the café bars on the piazzetta and watch the yachts moored in the harbour. Later we cruise back to Santa Margherita. This evening partake in a cooking class prior to enjoying dinner.

**TUESDAY 7 JUNE B****SANTA MARGHERITA - VENICE**

We say 'arrivederci' to the beautiful Cinque Terre this morning as our private coach collects us for our transfer to Venice. Enroute we make a stop in the beautiful town of Lucca, protected by massively thick 16th Century walls. Our tour guide will join us here for a walking tour and then allow us free time before we depart for Venice. We will make a stop for lunch along the highway and upon arrival in Venice will be transferred in our hotel by private water taxis.

**WEDNESDAY 8 JUNE B****VENICE**

This morning our guide we show us the highlights of Venice, one of the most beautiful cities in the world. This afternoon is at your leisure. The perfect opportunity for you to do as much, or as little as you want. Possibly embark on a gondola ride.

**THURSDAY 9 JUNE B****VENICE**

This morning we sail to the Islands of Murano, known throughout the world for its glass blowing. Next stop is Burano, famous not only for its lace and also for its fishermen's houses painted in bright colours. Last stop is Torcello, the earliest centre of civilisation in the estuary.

**FRIDAY 10 JUNE****VENICE - FLORENCE**

We are off again - this short trip has us arriving at our hotel in Florence early in the afternoon after a short sightseeing tour of the city. You will have time in the afternoon to visit the fantastic markets.

**SATURDAY 11 JUNE****FLORENCE - ROME**

This morning we will be collected from our hotel and make our way to Rome. On our way we will visit San Gimignano the fairytale 'town of towers' and then make our way to medieval Siena and view the Piazza del Campo, scene of the famous Palio horse race. Plenty of free time will be allowed so we can enjoy this



beautiful city before continuing on to our accommodation in Rome arriving late afternoon.

**SUNDAY 12 JUNE B****ROME**

This morning we avoid the lengthy queues again and explore one of the world's most extensive art collections with our local guide on this fascinating tour of the Vatican. Our guide will share the stories and secrets contained within the Museum's walls. See the imposing beauty of Saint Peter's Basilica and stop to admire the magnificent Saint Peter's Square before returning to our hotel.

**MONDAY 13 JUNE B, D****ROME**

This morning we wander visiting the Trevi Fountain, Spanish Steps and the Parthenon which are all in the vicinity of our hotel. This afternoon our organized tour begins with a panoramic view of the Colosseum before skipping the queue to enter the most symbolic of Rome's landmarks. Our local guide will bring the past to life as we listen to tales of gladiators, mock sea-battles and executions. We will then stop at the Arch of Constantine before entering the complex of the Palatine Hill – the most famous of Rome's hills. This evening we will have dinner at a special restaurant for our last evening.

**TUESDAY 14 JUNE B****ROME**

Today we will be collected from our hotel and transferred to Rome Airport to join our return flight to Singapore.

**WEDNESDAY 15 JUNE****SINGAPORE**

Arrive Singapore early this morning and transferred to our hotel for our overnight stay to break our return journey to Australia.

**THURSDAY 16 JUNE****SINGAPORE**

Today is at leisure, swimming, shopping and early in the evening we will be transferred to Singapore airport for our return flight to Australia.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

**TOUR PAYMENTS** A non-refundable deposit of \$500 per person is payable within 7 days of booking. The balance of payment is due not later than 20 March 2016.

**CANCELLATIONS** Cancellations fees apply. Cancellation fees may also apply to any additional services, reserved prior to, during and after the tour. Notice of all cancellations must be made in writing to Andrew Jones Travel on or before final payment due date 20 March 2016. Loss of deposit. After final payment due date: 100% of total price. Cancellation fees also apply to any additional services, reserved prior to, during and after the vacation.

If flight changes, including flight cancellations, are requested, revision fees or airline cancellation fees will apply. Andrew Jones Travel Pty. Ltd. and the carriers, accommodations, and other suppliers providing tour services shall all be known as the 'Operators' and reserve the right to cancel or re-schedule any vacation departure. If cancellation is made prior to departure of the tour, the only responsibility of the Operators will be to refund to the passenger the amount we have received for the reservation. We will try to re-book the same vacation with a different departure date, or a similar tour. Where the Operators have confirmed flights, we will try to confirm air seats for the selected new dates, subject to availability. The Operators cannot assume responsibility for any additional costs or any fees relating to the issuance and/or cancellation of air tickets or other travel arrangements.

**REVISION FEES** A fee of \$150 per transaction will be charged for any alteration or revision made to a reservation, plus any additional costs from Operators. Airline penalties may also apply. A change to traveller name, vacation date or tour itinerary at any time will be treated as a cancellation and new reservation; standard cancellation fees apply.
