FRIDAY 21 JUNE DEPART TASMANIA

Fly from Hobart or Launceston to London via Melbourne

SATURDAY 22 JUNE D LONDON

Upon arrival at London Heathrow we will be transferred to our centrally located hotel. We will explore the surrounding area including Trafalgar Square and Piccadilly Circus, all within a comfortable walk from our hotel. Stop for a coffee or a pint in a local pub before an early night.

SUNDAY 23 JUNE B LONDON

Today schedule your London sightseeing as you wish on an opentop bus tour. You may choose to stay on the bus for the complete circuit or get off and on at various places of interest along the route. There are different bus routes as well as a walking tour and a River Thames cruise. Visit either the Tower of London or Kensington Palace.

MONDAY 24 JUNE B,D LONDON - STRATFORD-UPON-AVON - YORK

We depart London this morning and drive north through the Cotswolds to Stratford-upon-Avon and visit Shakespeare's Birthplace. We see an exhibition about his life and work and walk through the house where he was born where rooms are furnished as they would have been in his day. We continue our journey north to the medieval city of York.

TUESDAY 25 JUNE B,D YORK - EDINBURGH

This morning we have a walking tour around central York to see medieval streets and houses and visit the stately York Minster, renowned for its stained glass and wonderful Gothic architectural details before travelling north into Scotland with a stop in the Borders region in Melrose to view the ruins of the abbey. On to Edinburgh and our accommodation. Dinner this evening is a Scottish Evening with bagpipes and lively music.

WEDNESDAY 26 JUNE B EDINBURGH

We discover Edinburgh's highlights on a city tour this morning. See the elegant 200-year-old Georgian "New Town" and the compact medieval city centered on the Royal Mile.

Tour Edinburgh Castle to view the

Crown Jewels of Scotland and enjoy splendid views of central Edinburgh. The remainder of the day is at your leisure.

THURSDAY 27 JUNE B,D EDINBURGH - ST ANDREWS

Today we travel north to St Andrews, famous for golfing and Scotland's oldest university, for a walking tour around the town and visit the picturesque ruins of St Andrews Cathedral. Stop in Pitlochry and drive through the awesome Highland scenery of the Grampian Mountains on our way to our hotel in Inverness, the main market town of the region.

FRIDAY 28 JUNE B,D LOCH NESS CRUISE - OBAN DISTILLERY

Enjoy more wonderful Highland views as you travel south. Relax on a scenic cruise of Loch Ness, Britain's largest and deepest lake and home to the elusive monster, "Nessie". Drive along the west coast to the town of Oban. Visit Oban Distillery to see how whisky is distilled and sample some at the end of the tour.

SATURDAY 29 JUNE B OBAN - BELFAST

This morning we bid farewell to the Highlands as we drive through Glen Coe and alongside Loch Lomond. We stop in Alloway at the Robert Burns Birthplace Museum to learn about the famous poet's life and poetry. Continue to Cairnryan for a short ferry ride to Belfast. The evening is free for independent dining, either in your hotel or in one of the many restaurants very close by.

SUNDAY 30 JUNE B,D BELFAST - DERRY

Tour the highlights of Belfast to see the impressive City Hall and Victorian buildings as well as the shipyards where RMS Titanic was built. Travel along the scenic Nine Glens of Antrim and visit the Giant's Causeway, hexagonal columns formed by volcanic activity over 60 million years ago. The huge columns have given rise to many legends. Continue to Derry for our overnight stay.

MONDAY 1 JULY B,D DERRY

Drive south to visit the Ulster American Folk Park near Omagh where you can see cozy cottages depicting a bygone way of life in rural Ireland with demonstrations of crafts and skills. Also see a typical sailing ship that would have transported emigrants as well as colonial American cabins. Return to Derry and join a local guide for a short walk around Derry's medieval city walls that completely encircle the old city center. Learn about the development of the settlement throughout the centuries and right up to today.

TUESDAY 2 JULY B,D DERRY - GALWAY

Travel through the Blue Stack Mountains to Donegal town. Tour Donegal Castle, built in the 15th century by an O'Donnell chieftain. Pause at Drumcliffe Churchyard to view the grave of W. B. Yeats, the Nobel Prize-winning poet, and again at Knock Shrine before continuing to Galway for a walking tour.

WEDNESDAY 3 JULY B CONNEMARA & "THE QUIET MAN"

Today explore scenic Connemara to admire how constantly-changing cloud formations give granite hills, sparkling lakes and peat bogs an added dimension. While visually stunning, this area is not good for farming with many tracts of bogland and sturdy sheep that wander over the hills. In Cong take a walking tour with a local guide to see locations for "The Quiet Man" movie, made in the village in 1952. Return to Galway for a panoramic drive around the city center.

THURSDAY 4 JULY B,D CLIFFS OF MOHER & KILLARNEY

Drive through the hills of the Burren to the coast to view the majestic Cliffs of Moher, which rise 700 feet and extend for five miles above the foaming Atlantic Ocean. Cross the wide River Shannon Estuary by ferry and head to Killarney, a little town that is world-famous due to its glorious location beside lakes and mountains.

FRIDAY 5 JULY B,L RING OF KERRY & SHEEPDOGS

Drive to the delightful town of Kenmare where gaily-painted shops display flowers. After a look around journey along part of the Ring of Kerry route to view some of the spectacular mountain scenery which is all around you. Visit a farm to watch a shepherd give his trained dogs commands to round up sheep and bring them back to the pen. Just outside Killarney tour the gracious 19th century Muckross House and enjoy a casual lunch before returning to Killarney. The rest of the day is at leisure.

SATURDAY 6 JULY B.D **BLARNEY CASTLE & WATERFORD**

Travel to Blarney Castle to kiss the famous "Stone of Eloquence" located in the battlements of the castle. Shop at the Blarney Woollen Mills, home of quality Irish-made merchandise. Then head to Cobh to visit the Titanic Experience which tells about the 123 Irish people who embarked on the RMS Titanic. Continue to Waterford and after dinner take a walking tour to learn about this 1,000-year-old port city.

SUNDAY 7 JULY B.D WATERFORD CRYSTAL & TAYLOR'S THREE ROCK

Tour the famous House of Waterford Crystal to watch molten glass being transformed into shimmering trophies by skilled blowers and cutters. Also view a huge selection of stemware in the showrooms. Visit a farm for tea and scones and enjoy an opportunity to talk to the owners about country life in Ireland. Travel to Dublin and check in to your hotel. In the evening dine at Taylor's Three Rock Pub, which is followed by a lively THURSDAY 11 JULY show with songs, stories and stepdancing.

MONDAY 8 JULY DUBLIN & BOOK OF KELLS

Spend the morning on a guided tour of Dublin to view elegant Georgian townhouses and brightly painted doors. Join a student guide on a brief walk through Trinity College's campus to view the illuminated manuscript of the Book of Kells. The afternoon is free for independent activities and dining.

TUESDAY 9 JULY B,D **WALES & CONWY**

Take a short ferry ride from Dublin to Holyhead in North Wales and drive to the town of Conwy. Tour Conwy Castle, a huge 13th century fortification built by King Edward I. Take a guided walk around the walled town with its quaint streets and houses and see the smallest house in Britain on the waterfront.



WEDNESDAY 10 JULY B.D **SNOWDONIA & BRECON BEACONS**

Travel through Snowdonia National Park to view the highest peaks in Wales and continue through the center of the country with thriving farms and towns. Cross the scenic Brecon Beacons National Park. Tour Cardiff Castle and dine at a fun Welsh banquet.

B.D **ROMAN BATHS & PLYMOUTH**

This morning head east to tour the Roman Baths and Pump Room, renowned for the mineral-rich hot springs and wonderfully preserved after two millennia. Arrive in Plymouth, now a vibrant waterfront city. Check in to your hotel, close to the harbour.

FRIDAY 12 JULY **EXPLORE CORNWELL & LAND'S END**

Browse around the typical Cornish village of Mevagissey, a fishing village with a colorful history of boat-building and smuggling. Drive to Land's End, the most westerly point of Britain. View the majestic outline of St. Michael's Mount, an important pilgrimage destination, and return to your hotel.

SATURDAY 13 JULY B.D STONEHENGE & WINDSOR CASTLE

Drive to Salisbury Plain to marvel at the prehistoric circle of vast monoliths of Stonehenge. Continue to Windsor to visit Windsor Castle, residence of The Queen and the largest inhabited castle in the world. After dinner we have a walking tour around the compact historic town.

SUNDAY 14 JULY WINDSOR

Today we will be transferred to Heathrow airport for our enroute stopover in Singapore.

MONDAY 15 JULY ARRIVE SINGAPORE

Arrive Singapore early this morning and transferred to our hotel for our overnight stay to break our return journey to Australia.

TUESDAY 16 JULY DEPART SINGAPORE

Today is at leisure, swimming, shopping and early in the evening we will be transferred to Singapore airport for our return flight to Australia.

WEDNESDAY 17 JULY ARRIVE AUSTRALIA

Today we arrive home and say goodbye to our new found friends.

TOUR PAYMENTS A non-refundable deposit of \$1800 per person is payable within 7 days of booking. The balance of payment is due not later than 21 March 2019.

CANCELLATIONS Cancellations fees apply. Cancellation fees may also apply to any additional services, reserved prior to, during and after the tour. Notice of all cancellations must be made in writing to Andrew Jones Travel on or before final payment due date. Loss of deposit. After final payment due date: 100% of total price. Cancellation fees also apply to any additional services, reserved prior to, during and after the vacation.

If flight changes, including flight cancellations, are requested, revision fees or airline cancellation fees will apply. Andrew Jones Travel Pty. Ltd. and the carriers, accommodations, and other suppliers providing tour services shall all be known as the 'Operators' and reserve the right to cancel or re-schedule any vacation departure. If cancellation is made prior to departure of the tour, the only responsibility of the Operators will be to refund to the passenger the amount we have received for the reservation. We will try to re-book the same vacation with a different departure date, or a similar tour. Where the Operators have confirmed flights, we will try to confirm air seats for the selected new dates, subject to availability. The Operators cannot assume responsibility for any additional costs or any fees relating to the issuance and/or cancellation of air tickets or other travel arrangements.

REVISION FEES A fee of \$150 per transaction will be charged for any alteration or revision made to a reservation, plus any additional costs from third party suppliers and all other operators and carriers. Airline penalties may also apply. A change to traveller name, vacation date or tour itinerary at any time will be treated as a cancellation and new reservation; standard cancellation fees apply.

Vacation prices are per person, based on two persons sharing a room. Single room supplements are listed where applicable.

ACCOMMODATIONS The accommodations listed in this brochure are intended to be used on this departure; however, if a change becomes necessary for any reason, the accommodations substituted will be equivalent in standard to those shown. Every effort is made to reserve your preferred room request. It may occasionally happen that an accommodation provides some double-bedded or twin-bedded rooms, as room configuration is at the discretion of individual hotels. BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE Porterage for one suitcase on vacation is included in the tour price. Airport porterage at beginning and end of the vacation is not included. Due to limited coach capacity, this single bag should have dimensions not exceeding 76x53x28cm (30x21x11") and weight not exceeding 20kg (44 lbs) or less if your aircarrier has stricter weight/dimension limitations. We recommend you consult your air carrier as size and weight limitations vary from airline to airline and even according to destination, and are becoming more restrictive. The Operators are not responsible for additional fees imposed by air carriers. Regulations within most airports require that travellers handle their own luggage through customs.

Your carry-on bagshould not exceed the dimensions of 30x28x14cm (12x11x6"). For safety reasons wheeled carry-on bags are not suitable as hand luggage on motor coaches and mini-buses.

No responsibility is accepted for loss of or damage to baggage or any of the tour participant's belongings. Baggage insurance is recommended.
