SUNDAY 16 JUNE
DEPART AUSTRALIA

MONDAY 17 JUNE
ARRIVE ATHENS

Today we arrive into Athens and meet with our local tour guide. We will transfer to our hotel, and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure to refresh and relax.

TUESDAY 18 JUNE **B,D**
ATHENS

This morning we explore Athens; seeing Constitution Square (Syntagma), the House of Parliament, the Memorial to the Unknown Soldier and the National Library. On your way to the Acropolis you will see Hadrian's Arch, the Temple of the Olympian Zeus and have a short stop at the Panathenaic Stadium, where the first Modern Olympic Games were held in 1896. At the Acropolis, visit the architectural masterpieces of the Golden Age of Athens: the Propylaea, the Temple of Athena Nike, the Erechtheion and finally the famous Parthenon. This afternoon is at leisure, and tonight we are treated to dinner and a folklore show.

WEDNESDAY 19 JUNE **B,L**
ATHENS - LEONIDIO

We check out of the hotel this morning and leave Athens via the coastal road. We will have a short stop at the Corinth Canal, which we revisit again later in our trip. We then drive on and visit the Theatre of Epidaurus famous for its remarkable acoustics. Continue to the town of Nafplion for a short stop before heading for Mycenae to see the Archaeological Site and Tomb of Agamemnon. We will enjoy our lunch at a local restaurant.

THURSDAY 20 JUNE **B,D**
LEONIDIO

Today is free to relax at the hotel or explore the local area as we have our coach & guide available for any group activity. Dinner tonight is at a local restaurant.

FRIDAY 21 - TUESDAY 25 JUNE
LEONIDIO - ZAKYNTHOS

After breakfast we drive to Olympia for a visit to the Archaeological Site with the sanctuary of Olympian Zeus, the Ancient Stadium and the Archaeological Museum. We then continue to Kyllini to catch a ferry to the island Zakynthos. No trip to Greece would be complete without a stay on one of the beautiful islands – the Venetians named this island

the *Flower of the East* due to its nobility and fertility. Today's visitors come for its endless beaches, and seeking indelible moments. Over the next few days we can explore this stunning island, experiencing local island life. We can recharge, relax, read a book, and meet with locals in tavernas. Whilst on Zakynthos, we will enjoy two excursions to absorb the very best of this island's unique culture.

WEDNESDAY 26 JUNE **B,D**
ZAKYNTHOS - ARACHOVA

This morning we take the ferry from Zakynthos to Kyllini, and drive to Arachova; crossing the magnificent bridge over the Corinthian Bay from Rion to Antirion and passing the picturesque towns of Nafpactos and Itea.

THURSDAY 27 JUNE **B,L**
ARACHOVA

We visit the Archaeological site of Delphi, the UNESCO Heritage Site home to the Temple of Apollo and a famous oracle. We visit to the Sanctuary of Apollo, the Athenian Treasury, and the Museum of Delphi for a guided visit. After lunch at a local restaurant we might like to relax at the hotel or explore Arachova on our own.

FRIDAY 28 JUNE **B,L**
ARACHOVA - KALAMBAKA

This morning we depart for Kalambaka, a small town situated at the foot of the astonishing Meteora monasteries; with a brief stop en-route at Thermopylae to visit Leonida's Monument. This afternoon our tour will take us to places that only the locals know. Enjoy amazing views, learn about the history, and traditions of the place. High up on the rocks, inside the caves, you will see the 1000-year-old Bandoavas' hermitages; and learn the history of a very old Byzantine church, one of the oldest churches in Greece. Enjoy panoramic views, and find the perfect spot to capture the sunset.

SATURDAY 29 JUNE **B,D**
KALAMBAKA

Today we visit two of the monasteries and discover the natural beauty and the cultural heritage of this area. Many visitors never learn that just few kilometers from Kalambaka there is one of the most important prehistoric caves in the world, with archaeological findings dating back to 130,000 BC! Your tour includes a visit to Theopetra's prehistoric cave to discover this ancient man-made structure, a stone wall dating back to 26,000BC. You may see chance

to see the petrified footprints of a 7-year-old child on the caves' floor, who walked on the ashes 60,000 years ago.

SUNDAY 30 JUNE **B,D**
KALAMBAKA - ATHENS

Today we travel by the local commuter train to Athens, enjoying the scenery on the way. On arrival we will be transferred to our hotel and check-in. This evening is an opportunity to explore Athens. Meander the city and visit some of the liveliest districts in Athens. Plaka is alive with its maze of colourful streets, and the drifting aroma of moussaka and garlic prawns to tickle your taste buds. Don't miss anything of the city's cultural past. Pay a visit to the National Archaeological museum, or the Cycladic Art Museum.

MONDAY 1 JULY **B,D**
ATHENS

This morning we will transfer from our hotel to Pireaus Port to commence our cruise of the Adriatic, onboard Ponant's *Le Lyrial*. *Le Lyrial* embodies the subtle alliance between luxury, intimacy and well-being – a signature of Ponant. The elegance of this luxury mega-yacht, along with her intimate size, make this a rare and innovative cruise option.

TUESDAY 2 JULY **B,L,D**
HYDRA

Sail into Hydra this morning, an unusual gem belonging to the Saronic islands and located to the east of the Peloponnese. There are no cars here and the harbour town is layered up the slopes of a mountainous bay. We may be surprised to see beautiful traditional stone mansions alongside the multi-coloured caïques along the quays. Further along the shore, within the walls of the "Monastery of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary" is a museum of Byzantine art. Collections from Athens National History Museum are exhibited in the elegant villa Koundouriotis. We then transit the Corinth Canal. The Corinth Canal cuts through the Isthmus of Corinth, turning the Peloponnese into an island as it separates the region from the Greek mainland. Inaugurated in 1893, the canal is a little over 6km long and enables merchant vessels and passengers to avoid a long 400km detour around the peninsula. The two sides of the canal reach a height of approximately fifty metres. From the exterior decks, don't miss this unique opportunity to watch the ship as it navigates along the narrow strip of water encased between tall, ochre cliffs. What an experience!

WEDNESDAY 3 JULY

B,L,D

IGOUMENITSA

In the Epirus region, Igoumenitsa is a charming little port town bordered by the Ionian Sea, in north-west Greece. Surrounded by mountains, it faces the island of Corfu. The coastal path offers beautiful views over the “Emerald Island.” Not far from the town are several sites that are worthy of interest, such as the Gitani Archaeological Site, in a magnificent natural setting surrounded by water, and the Holy Monastery of Giromeri in Filiates. Dating from the 14th century, the Monastery perches like an eagle’s nest on mountainous slopes wooded with hundred-year-old sycamores, not far from the border with Albania.

THURSDAY 4 JULY

BAY OF KOTOR - DUBROVNIK

The long walls of the city of Kotor unfurl before our eyes as we sail the bay. Admire this medieval construction enclosed between the sea and the rugged cliffs from the decks of our ship. The still, deep waters of the bay plus the clouds of mist create a surreal and magical atmosphere. Small islands with churches and fortresses built on them remind us that a proud maritime people has lived here for centuries, in this bay that forms a perfect natural harbour, used by sailors since ancient times. On arrival into Dubrovnik, we travel to Cavtat and Konavle, two small picturesque towns steeped in history. The picture-perfect village of Cavtat is naturally protected by a rocky headland that still has remnants of an old fort. Cobble streets and alleys meet the palm tree lined promenade that winds its way around the harbor. Konavle is a region with preserved natural, unique and exceptionally precious rural architecture, numerous monuments of the thousand-year-old history of this area. We will arrive into Dubrovnik in the late afternoon. Dubbed the “Pearl of the Adriatic,” Dubrovnik is famous for its spectacular seafront location on the Dalmatian coast coupled with its evocative and historic old city center, with impressive architecture and its designation as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Wander around its picturesque old streets and alleys, before returning to the ship.

FRIDAY 5 JULY

B,L,D

MIJET - KORČULA

Mljet is a splendid, pristine island is located off the Pelješac Peninsula. and untouched nature awaits you in

the protected forests of Mljet National Park. On the Veliko Jezero lake sits a natural, cultural-historical and tourist delicacy - the picturesque Isle of Saint Mary with the church and the Benedictine monastery dating from the 12th century. We then take a short cruise to the island of Korčula – abundant in beautiful beaches and bays, luxurious hotels and summer houses, centuries-old olive groves and vineyards and villas. There are also ancient villages that seem to have been lost in time, luring the tourists from all over the world to this island. The “must see” sights are the Cathedral of St. Marco, the center of religious life, and the most beautiful gothic Renaissance monument in the old town of Korčula. Korčula is also famous for its gastronomic delicacies, typical for the Mediterranean region.

SATURDAY 6 JULY

B,L,D

HVAR

Off the coast of Split, Hvar will surprise you by its long-standing traditions. Stari Grad is nestled by a cove on the north-west coast, surrounded by dry stone wall structures on the Stari Grad plains. These have been designated a UNESCO World Heritage site because they were built in the time of the Ancient Greeks. From these parcels of land come wines and olive oil manufactured manually. In the upper part of town, you will discover hams and cheeses made by local producers. The city of Hvar is of a luxurious Mediterranean nature, rich in culture and historical heritage.

SUNDAY 7 JULY

B,L,D

OPATIJA

This elegant Istrian seaside location evokes an atmosphere of olden day holiday charm. The Opatija coastline is scattered with castles and layered gardens on hillsides which you can admire during a walk on the Lungomare. On this coastal path, famous for its panoramic terraces, and built in the early 20th century, you will find the *Maiden with a Seagull*, a graceful statue embodying life on the water’s edge. Further along the shoreline, you will notice the Saint-James Abbey which gives its name to the town “Opatija”, meaning “abbey” in Croatian. It’s been one of the most “fashionable” tourist destination on the eastern coast of the Adriatic for more than 150 years.

MONDAY 8 JULY

DISEMBARK VENICE

TOUR PAYMENTS A non-refundable deposit of \$2500 per person is payable within 7 days of booking. An interim payment of \$3000 is due no later than 3 January 2018. The balance of payment is due not later than 30 March 2019.

CANCELLATIONS Deposits are strictly non-refundable. Cancellation fees may also apply to any additional services, reserved prior to, during and after the tour. Notice of all cancellations must be made in writing to Andrew Jones Travel on or before final payment due date 30 March 2019. Loss of deposits. After final payment due date: 100% of total price. Cancellation fees also apply to any additional services, reserved prior to, during and after the vacation.

If flight changes, including flight cancellations, are requested, revision fees or airline cancellation fees will apply. Andrew Jones Travel Pty. Ltd. and the carriers, accommodations, and other suppliers providing tour services shall all be known as the 'Operators' and reserve the right to cancel or re-schedule any vacation departure.
